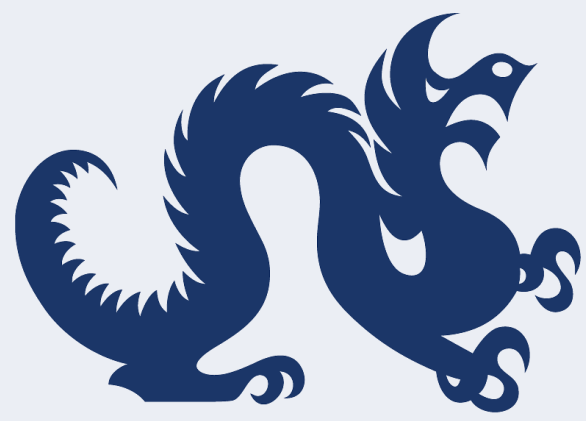

STAR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

STUDENTS TACKLING ADVANCED RESEARCH

Drexel's flagship undergraduate research program

Conduct faculty-mentored research, scholarship, or creative work full-time during the summer after your freshman year while earning a stipend and living in free on-campus housing.

Opportunities are available for students in **all colleges & disciplines**. Students in the program write an abstract, design a research poster, and present their research at the end of the summer.

To be eligible for STAR, you must:

- Be a first-year student in good academic standing
- Be able to commit to ten weeks of full-time mentored activity during summer term
- Have a genuine interest in gaining research, scholarly, or creative experience

Students can apply for the STAR Scholars Program while applying to Drexel University or during the Winter Term of their first year at Drexel.
