The COVID-19 pandemic has presented a wide variety of challenges for students and their families — we at Drexel University are focused on providing all Dragons with the support, resources, and opportunities that will allow them to reach their fullest potential as students and scholars. As part of our ongoing effort to help students as they navigate obstacles presented by COVID-19 — along with complications arising from the nationwide response — we have implemented the following policy changes to further assist individuals as they consider their academic options.

TEST-OPTIONAL POLICY

Under our Test-Optional policy, you are able to choose whether you wish to submit standardized test scores to be considered as part of your application to Drexel. If you do decide to submit scores, you'll have the opportunity to exercise our Test-Flexible option to determine which scores are submitted. This policy will provide students with greater flexibility and alleviate numerous concerns, including cancellations of SAT and ACT administrations.

WAIVING OF APPLICATION FEES

In-State First-Year Applicants: In order to better support students who are looking to remain in-state and begin their college career closer to home, we have waived the application fees for all Pennsylvania first-year applicants entering in fall 2021.

Transfer Students: Additionally, to facilitate a more streamlined transition for students in search of a university experience that is more conducive to their individual needs, all application fees for transfer students entering in 2020–2021 have also been waived.

WINTER ENTRY PROGRAM

Designed to accommodate students who require more time to prepare before beginning their college career, the Winter Entry Program provides the option to start your first year at Drexel in the winter quarter, starting in January 2021. As a Winter Entry student, you will receive the same level of academic rigor and preparation your first year as your peers starting in the fall, will be eligible for the same resources and campus activities, and will be at the same point in your plan of study as your fall entry peers as you begin your second year. The deadline for all Winter Entry applications is October 1, 2020.
