A live question-and-answer session will follow the keynote address by U.S. Sen. Kirsten Gillibrand (D-NY) at VisionForward's **National Caregiving Summit** on March 4. The virtual event runs from 1 to 3:30 p.m. ET. It is free and open to all.

Leading the Q&A session will be Alix Lowe-Server, the senator's top advisor on paid family leave, childcare, education and housing policy, judiciary issues, civil rights and reproductive rights.

In this role, Lowe-Server develops policy proposals, drafts and negotiates legislation, and secures stakeholder support.

VisionForward Forms Strategic Leaders Group

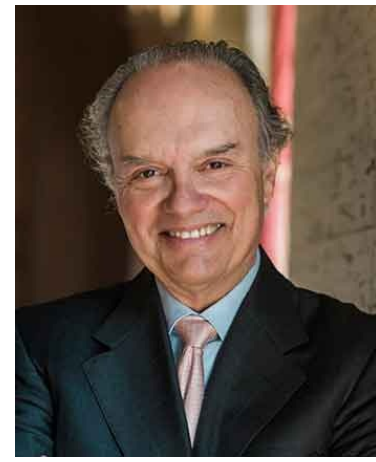
