2024 CONTEST INFO

The contest is open to all high school students in the United States and will culminate in an exhibition at the photography program gallery in February 2025 in conjunction with an online exhibition on a website dedicated to the contest. High school students may enter all types of photographic processes (black/white, color, silver prints, digital prints, and historical processes).

This competition does not accept AI-generated photos for submission. All submissions for the 2024 Drexel University High School Photography Contest must be submitted online to

RULES OF ENTRY

There is a \$10 entry fee to enter a maximum of 3 images into the contest. Artist must be a high school student in the United States.

This competition does not accept AI-generated photos for submission. Only photographs captured and edited by humans, without the use of AI algorithms or any other form of artificial intelligence, are eligible for entry. The competition is dedicated to celebrating human creativity and originality in photography, and therefore, AI-generated content is not allowed. We appreciate your understanding and adherence to the competition rules. Artists may be required to provide their RAW file for proof of eligibility in this contest.

Applicants may upload 1-3 images (jpg). For good quality and fast uploads, image files should be sized around 2400 px @ 72dpi and MUST be under 5 MB. The slideroom portal offers additional instructions for submitting work and helping new applicants get started. For technical assistance, go to <https://support.slideroom.com>

Each artist warrants that they have obtained all necessary releases from models and other subjects featured in photographs selected for exhibition.

Artists agree to let Drexel University Photography Program use submitted images for promotional materials. Accepted artists may be asked for a higher resolution file than originally submitted.

Submission of an entry to this competition implies acknowledgement that entrant data is available to the university and acceptance of all the concerns here stated.

NOTIFICATION

Artists whose work has been selected for display will be notified on or about December 17, 2024.

EXHIBITION NOTES

Selected artwork must be received no later than January 16, 2025. Artwork must be matted, outside dimensions of the mat must be 11x14.
